

**Level 3 & Xcel Bronze State Protocols to Keep Everyone Safe!!**

- Only two spectators per athlete will be allowed inside the building for each session. No athletes, spectators or coaches will be allowed into the venue until the DOORS OPEN TIME for each session. ***Please DO NOT COME IN EARLY!!*** We need time to get the group before you out and to disinfect high touched areas.
  - Any siblings competing in subsequent sessions will not be counted as spectators.
- The spectator fee is \$15 and includes anyone entering the spectator area, regardless of age. Only athletes competing in subsequent sessions will be allowed in without payment. Programs are \$5 and shout outs are \$3. CASH ONLY PLEASE.
- All spectators, volunteers, judges and coaches are required to wear a mask AT ALL TIMES. No eating will be allowed in the competition area.
- Athletes will be required to wear a mask with the exception of while performing on equipment.
- Sessions will be kept to a maximum of 48 gymnasts, meaning 6 or less gymnasts per rotation.
- We ask that you bring the MINIMUM number of coaches for the number of athletes you have competing. We understand that many clubs have different event coaches. However, this is Level 3 and Bronze so we are confident that any coach attending can manage the job alone.
- Open stretch will occur at your first event with the exception of bars which will stretch at floor with the floor rotation.
- Gymnasts, coaches and spectators will be asked to socially distance themselves from others. Bleachers and benches for seating will be marked. Otherwise, the responsibility falls to the individual to assist in this effort.
  - There will be no formal march in, just an announcement of teams at each event.
- Awards will occur directly on the competition floors immediately following the competition. Athletes can sit near the edges of the floors or stay at their last event. The places will be spread out among the 2 floors (each place about 8 feet from the other) so no athlete will be standing directly next to another. For any team awards, you may come up with your entire team (masked) or you may send up one athlete/coach, based on the comfort level of your team.
- Hospitality for coaches will be offered with dinner served Friday, lunch and dinner served Saturday and lunch served Sunday. Packaged snacks and drinks will be available at all times. Hospitality will feature individually packaged meals or meals served by designated hospitality staff. No open buffet items will be offered.
